The MSWE team composed of Jose Hernandez, Debra Mitchell, Lissett Capeles and Aliea McBooth met with Mr. Frato on Monday, August 16th, 2010. The meeting took place at their eastside Lot. This is a new lot which presently is not housing any debris.

During this meeting, Joe Frato asked about the tipping fee the City would charge at the MSWE facility. He brought to light that small “mom and pop” collectors already pay for equipment, licenses, staff and other expenses and would also have to pay the City a tipping fee, which could be seen as undesirable. We explained that we could not provide him with this information at the present moment.

Joe also stated that a partnership between them and the City would be beneficial as they could receive the C&D and house it without penalties until needed by the City. When asked about how many tons he could provide, he was nonresponsive.

He also asked whether the City would be willing to help locate a lot with at least 25 acres for a new westside lot.

They also mentioned the value of shingles and wanted to know how the City would compensate for them for not selling the shingles and giving them to the City.
